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Kia ora koutou te whānau o Burnham,

In today's newsletter I have included a Term 2 update on the work of our Kāhui Ako. This also includes information about the purpose of the Kāhui Ako. As you are aware I have been appointed as one of the lead principals of our Kāhui Ako. I will spend one day a week in this role. The BOT have appointed Linda Douglas (Sweeny) to provide the backfill for this position. Linda is taking on a number of key tasks from the BOT

strategic plan and will be working on these throughout the year. Linda was the Associate Principal of the senior school at Burnham for a number of years and has completed the Aspiring Principal's programme. Linda has a great deal of experience she brings to this role. Congratulations Linda!

Tonight is our whanau hui at 6pm in Room 1. At the meeting we will be asking for recommendations on who the BOT can ask to be co-opted onto the BOT as a Maori representative. Every BOT requires a Maori representative, this is a legal requirement. Tyron Rapana (Raps) has been our Maori representative for a number of years now, but he recently decided to resign due to other commitments. Raps will be missed on the BOT. I would like to thank him for the time and energy he put into our school while on the BOT. Raps has also supported our kapa haka, whanau hui and our EOTC programme. I am sure this will continue. With Raps leaving we need someone to step into this role. Please take time to think of who might be interested in this role and bring your suggestions to our Whanau Hui tonight. Everyone is welcome to attend. Whanau hui is one way we have of engaging with whanau to ensure we are meeting your children's needs. It is also a wonderful way to get to know one another. Past outcomes of whanau hui have been the upgrade of our girls' kapa haka uniforms, the decision to make kapa haka optional rather than compulsory and the establishment of bilingual education at Burnham. So please attend if you possibly can, this is an important hui to be a part of.

The children have been finalizing their plans/ideas for our new playground and preparing presentation for our next BOT meeting. Room 5 currently have their designs on display in the library. Feel free to come on in and take a look.

Today we sent a team to the zone gymnastics tournament. This was a first for Burnham. Thanks to the parents and a big sister who took these students to this event. And to Whaea Hiria for getting them on the road at 7am this morning! The students have been practicing in the hall with the support of Ms Smith and Mrs Trowbridge.
